NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern.

Please read and follow the following rules and regulations:

By entering this trial, exhibitors are acknowledging that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the exercises safely.

There will be two trials on Saturday—one in the morning and one in the afternoon, with the afternoon trial starting approximately one hour after the completion of the morning trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing club. Greater Kansas City Dog Training Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable.

There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Faxed, telegraph, telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries will **not** be accepted which specifies any conditions as to their acceptance.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded for such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. A **recording fee** of \$.50 and a **\$3.00 AKC event service fee** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging. Consult the judging program for time of judging. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through the public address system, runners or stewards for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitors whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.

No un-entered dogs will be allowed in the trial building during the regular show hours. This is in accordance with the AKC "Rules Applying to Dog Shows", Chapter 11, Section 11. Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date.

All crates are to be on rugs or pads that protect court flooring from scratches and/or spills.

Food/water for dogs must be kept inside crates.

All dogs must remain on leash or kenneled unless showing in the ring.

Dog exercise areas are to be set up in the grass area past the upper west parking lot.

Dogs are not to be exercised on the east or south sides of the building right outside the door.

Exhibitors are to clean up, inside/outside of the building, pertaining to their dog(s).

NO SMOKING inside building.

NO ALCOHOL permitted on show grounds.

NO FIREARMS permitted on show grounds.

NO GLASS CONTAINERS OR BOTTLES of any kind are allowed in the facility.

All present are asked to refrain from using audible cell phone ringers in exhibition area.
